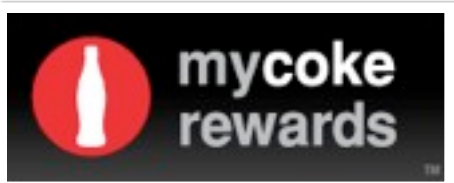

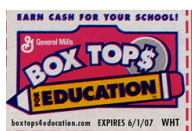

If so, please drop them in the Our Lady's slot as you exit the store.

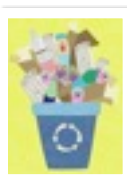
