

Scrip Gift Cards Fundraiser

Scrip is simply a word that means “substitute money” – in other words, scrip is gift certificates from national and local retailers. They’re the same gift certificates that you buy at the store. Many popular retailers participate in our scrip program including Macy’s, L.L. Bean, T.J. Maxx, Shell, Star Market, Macaroni Grill, Panera Bread, Dunkin Donuts, Starbucks and many, many others.

You’re probably asking yourself how these stores help us raise money. It’s simple -- scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift certificates to our organization at a discount. Member families like yours buy the certificates for **full** face value, they redeem them for **full** face value, and our school keeps the difference as revenue. And scrip is exciting, because everybody wins:

- The retailer gets cash up front and repeat business...
- You get a powerful fundraising alternative that involves ***no selling***...
- You don’t have to purchase items you don’t want. You can purchase the cards for stores where you always shop or give them as gifts!

The beauty of scrip is that you put your regular household shopping dollars to work. You earn money for our school without spending a single additional penny. Just spend your regular shopping dollars with scrip at the stores that participate in the scrip program! And scrip can be used for just about any household purchase including food, clothing, entertainment, gasoline and even dining out. When asked for your enrollment code, please enter **23B8CCLF18456**, which should associate you with Our Lady’s Academy and show Linda Cabeca as the coordinator. Once you decide to make a purchase, just add the cards you want to buy to your cart and then you have 2 options to pay. You can either send Linda a check made out to Our Lady’s Academy or you can set up your account to debit directly from your checking account via Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT), which they call Presto Pay. The choice is yours!
