

Questions you can ask at an interview

What does a typical day look like for a ninth grader? (courses, start/end of school day, etc.)

Are there expectations of the students over the summer?

Is there orientation in the fall? What is it like?

How much homework will you have?

Is there a dress code? What is it?

What type of Advanced Placement classes do they offer?

Ask if there are have particular classes you are interested in (math, science, art, music)....

What are the requirements (specific courses) for graduation?

Do students get involved with community service?

What are the expectations of the student's participation in after school activities?

Are athletics after school required? If so, how often?

Extra-curricular: what activities/clubs do they offer: sports, art, music, chess, etc.

Are there extra costs/fees?

Are there scholarships? How do you get one?

What are the average class sizes?

What are the leadership opportunities at the school?

Can you go off campus during the day?

What type of orientation happens in the fall?

How many new ninth graders will there be? Where are they from?

Do students have advisors? How often do you meet with them? What is their role?

Why would you go to an advisor vs. guidance?

What type of interscholastic competition do you offer?

How diverse is the school?
