

1:1 Learning

Note to sixth graders and families new to the middle school; Our Lady's Middle School is a 1:1 learning environment. Families of OLA students in sixth grade and above are required to provide their student with a laptop computer for daily use at school. Much of our curriculum is computer-based and requires a relatively recent laptop to access materials and complete classwork. Chromebook computers are acceptable and are often less expensive than Apple or Windows computers.
